



## **COVID SAFETY PROCEDURES:**

1. Face masks are **optional**.
  - Students may wear face masks as desired by the parents/guardians.
  - Our teachers will also have the option of wearing face masks if they choose.
2. Parents will have limited access to buildings during the school day.
  - Parents will no longer be able to accompany students to classrooms or eat with students during lunch time.
  - Parents are allowed to come to the main office.
3. Parents must sign a waiver form for their children.
  - Signed waiver forms for each student must be on file, signifying that parents/guardians understand TCS is not liable if your child were to contract COVID-19. We cannot guarantee that our TCS family is 100% risk free of contracting COVID-19.
  - Waiver forms will be mailed out and can also be picked up at orientation.
4. Water fountains will be unavailable.
  - Students will no longer be able to use our water fountains.
  - Students are encouraged to bring labeled water bottles that can be used during the school day.
5. School buildings and classrooms will be cleaned regularly.
  - Teachers will have a cleaning checklist that must be completed at the end of every school day.
  - Teachers will also clean frequently touched surfaces throughout each school day.
  - The buildings and classrooms will be fogged by our cleaning crew twice a week.
6. Morning Drop-Off
  - After 7:20 AM, elementary and middle school students need to be dropped off in front of the gym.
  - High school students will need to enter through the front doors of the high school building (by flag pole).
  - Side doors of the high school building will not be in use at all throughout the day. All students and staff will exit and enter the building through the front door.
  - Please do not leave until your child has been cleared to go to class.

7. Afternoon Pick-Up

- In an effort to keep classes separated, afternoon pick-up will look different than it has in the past.
- We are having to dismiss classes at specific times. There will be several lanes that will have signs posted directing you where to go.
- All pick-up traffic will need to enter campus off of Greenville Blvd.
- All pick-up traffic will exit campus onto Golden Road.

8. Field Trips

- Field trips will be permitted this year.
- Parent chaperones must provide their own transportation.
